

How to Access Your U.Plan Distribution Roster

Your U.Plan Distribution Roster, which reflects the U.Plan Tuition Certificate proceeds for students who have confirmed enrollment at your school, is available for download within your U.Plan online account. To view your roster online, please follow the steps below.

► **Access Your Roster:** Log in at uplan.mefa.org.

1 Select the Reporting tab

2 Select Roster by Disbursement Date and the action, Get Report

► **Run the Report**

3 Enter a beginning date and an ending date to view all disbursements processed within that time frame

- Disbursements are processed weekly on Friday
- For most institutions, the first scheduled disbursement date for the academic year is the first Friday in August

4 Select Run Report

5 Export report to Excel if desired

The last column indicates the amount that should be credited to each student's account

If you see a negative amount in the **School Contribution** column, the school is entitled to keep the excess funds because the increase of tuition/mandatory fees is less than the rate of CPI plus 2% but greater than the U.Plan participant's cash payment.
