U. Plan Transition- Why the Move Online

For Families:

- Access to Year Round Savings
- Ability to Automate Savings, Check Account Balances and Request Disbursements More Quickly
- Streamlined Process Overall

For College Admins

- Ability to Manage Rosters
- Set-Up EFT to Receive Funds (optional, not required)
- Quicker Access to Information

College Admin Access- Email from U.S. Bank

- For security reasons, users were pre-provided by U.S. Bank, our partner financial organizations.
- You should have received an email from MEFA explaining the transition and then 2 emails from U.S. Bank: one with your username and one with your temporary provisioning code.
 - If you did not receive these, or did not take action, please let us know. The emails went out the end of June and the code was only valid for 14 days, so we are collecting names to re-provision.
 - Also, we are encouraging everyone to check their junk/spam folders!

Recently, an announcement was sent to all individuals saving in MEFA's <u>U.Plan</u> Prepaid Tuition Program notifying them of exciting enhancements to the program. With these enhancements, <u>U.Plan</u> savers will now have the ability to manage their account online, save throughout the year for the purchase of Tuition Certificates, and send funds directly to a college or university.

As part of these enhancements, we have also enhanced functionality for our U.Plan school administrators. Beginning today, U.Plan administrators will now have the ability to:

- Create an online U.Plan school administrator user account
- View and manage U.Plan rosters online
- Set-up ACH/EFT to receive U.Plan funds electronically

All of these changes are possible because of our work with U.S. Bank Global Fund Services. A leader in consumer banking, U.S. Bank Global Fund Services now acts as the U.Plan's program record keeper, helping to manage our 24-7 online access and providing valuable customer support. MEFA remains the administrator of the program.

What We Need from You:

STEP 1: We are encouraging all college and university U.P.Ian administrators to create a school administrator user account. Shortly, you will receive two emails from U.S. Bank. The first email will contain a link to set up your online user account. The second email will contain your secret code to complete registration. This code will remain valid for 14 days. Please be on the lookout for this email as it is scheduled to arrive today (please check your spam folder as well). For convenience, we have attached screen shots of the log in process.
