


How to Participate

- The MassHire Lowell Career Center is part of the Massachusetts One-Stop Career Center System serving the communities of Billerica, Chelmsford, Dracut, Dunstable, Lowell, Tewksbury, Tyngsborough and Westford. The Lowell Career Center operates under the direction of the City of Lowell and is chartered by the MassHire Greater Lowell Workforce Board. Through this model, local employment and training services have been consolidated to build a strong workforce development system
- We are charged with overseeing and implementing workforce development initiatives throughout the Workforce Investment Area. Board members offer a wide range of skills and experience and include representatives from local businesses, educational Institutions, Community Based Organizations, labor unions, governmental agencies, economic development bodies, and Chambers of Commerce.




BUILDING A FOUNDATION FOR A STRONG WORKFORCE

Specialized Programs

- Work Experience Programming- in FY23 between 450 and 550 young people will gain exposure to work and training opportunities while making wages between \$16.25 and \$18.75 per hour.
- Pre-Employment Transition Services- Specialized light touch programs for young people on 504's or IEPS at 7 local schools
- Young Parent Program- High School Equivalency, life skills, occupational training and job search assistance for young parents

Specialized Programs Continued

- Skill Up- Workforce Readiness and skills attainment for young people committed to DYS
- Pathways Coaching- In school services for alternative and charter high schools to coach young people along in their careers during the school day
