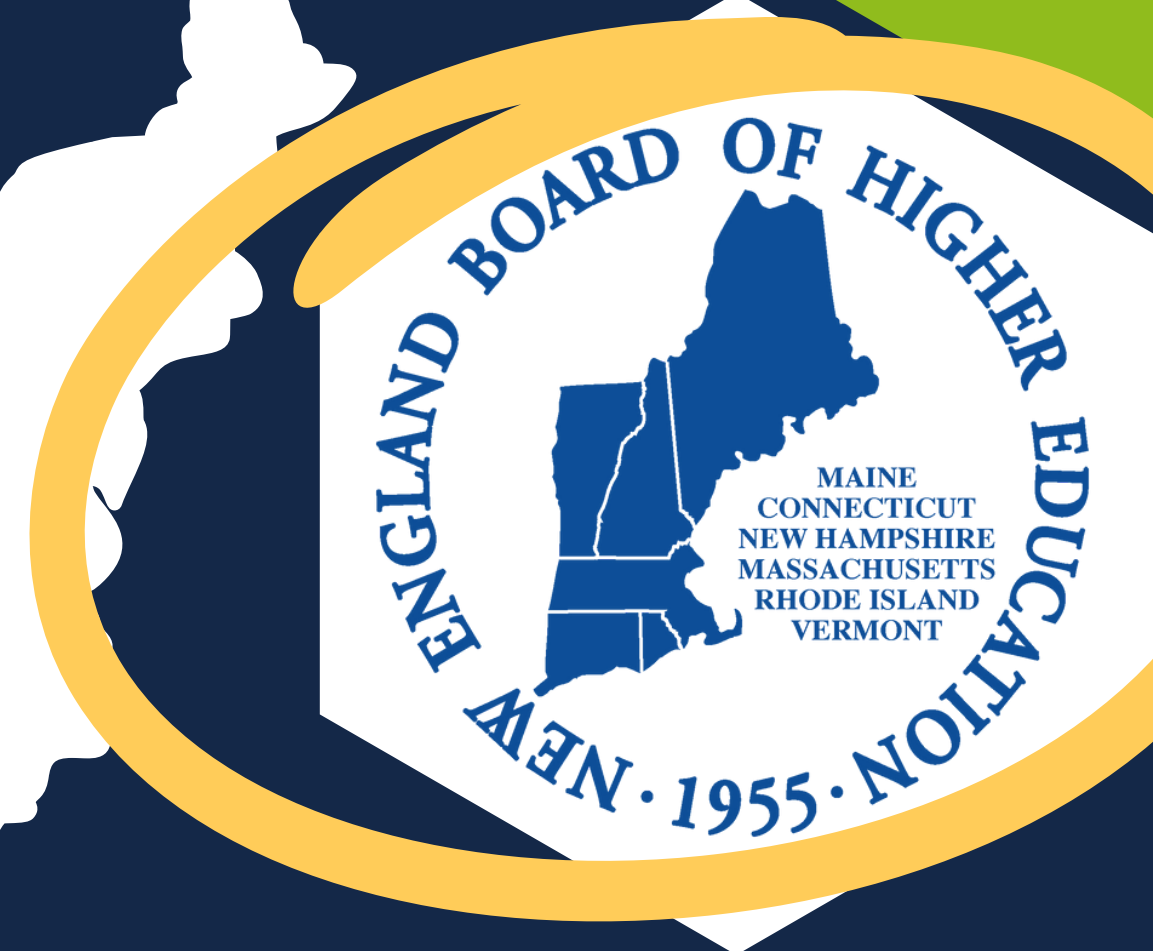

# What is Tuition Break?

We help **New England residents** save on tuition at **out-of-state public** colleges and universities **within New England**.

Students pay **discounted tuition** when enrolled in an **eligible major** at a college or university **outside of your home state**.

# Program Categories

## Specialized Programs

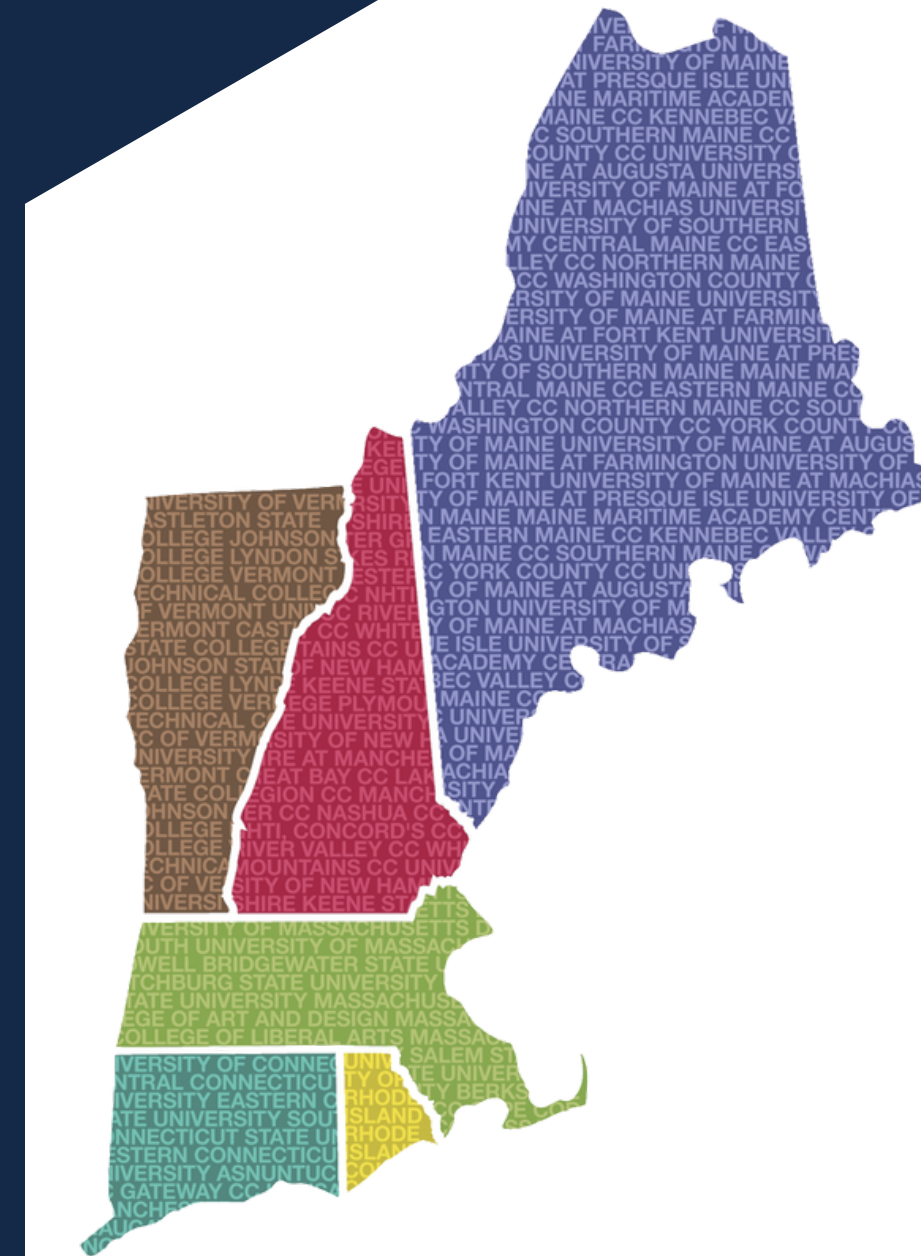
Discounted tuition is available to students who reside in New England states where this specific academic program is **not available at a public university.**

## Flexible Programs

Discounted tuition is available to **all out-of-state residents of New England**, regardless of whether the program is available in their home state.

As of Fall 2023, **about a third** of our partner colleges will offer all of their academic programs through Tuition Break's Flexible Policy.

# Accessing Tuition Break

- 3** **Submit your admission application** to the college(s) and list the eligible program on your application. Be sure to **research any additional eligibility requirements** at each.
