
Program Categories

Specialized Programs

Discounted tuition is available to students who reside in New England states where this specific academic program is n**ot available at a public university**.

Flexible Programs

Discounted tuition is available to **all out-of-state residents of New England**, regardless of whether the program is available in their home state.
